(CIP) 5 DAYS

GENERAL ASSUMPTIONS

1. Definition and availability of course.

This Curriculum is designed to show to general practitioners and specialists how to integrate basic implantology into private practice. Training in treatment planning, patient evaluation, decision making, surgical implant placement and implant prosthetics will be provided along with hands-on model – based training with implant system. Step – by – step techniques will be presented to allow for safe and predictable implant placement. Apart from hands- on model training live implant surgeries and live implant prosthetic treatment will be performed with the possibility of observation at the patient's site and simultaneous live transmission. Curriculum Implant Prosthetics postgraduate studies involve 40 educational hours and 18 congress educational hours with total amount of 58 hours.

2. Course schedule

Clinical part at Duda Clinic College of Dental Medicine DC CDM involves 5 days with 8.00-17.00, 8 hours of educational time one week from Monday to Friday together with the scheduled 188 congress educational hours.

3. Curriculum Topics

Basic of Implantology – anatomy of hard and soft tissues, planning in implantology, indications and contraindications, estimation of the amount and quality of the bone, basics of the implant prosthetics treatment, implantological proceedings step by step, implant positioning in 3 dimensions within anatomical conditions, Noebl Clinician.

Rentgenodiagnosis and navigation – diagnosis and planning (clinical, radiological, 3D models), from panoramic rtg to navigational planning, cast and surgical guides preparation, NobelGuide, different planning and navigation systems.

Implant prosthetics – red-white esthetics, clinical and technical stages, impression techniques, scanners, CAD-CAM, Noeble Procera

Crowns and bridges – single tooth replacement, treatment with multiple single crowns, bridge supplies, tooth implant borne restorations, procedures in the treatment chair and in the laboratory, restorative materials (metal alloys, ceramics, composites), full mouth reconstructions.

Overdentures – retention elements (pins, ball Anchorage), complex retention elements (telescopic, bars) arrangement of remaining teeth, miniimplants, all – on -4 concept, procedures in the treatment chair and in the laboratory

Immediate implantology and immediate loading – immediate and delayed implantation, augmentation after extraction, immediate loading – criteria of qualifications, delayed implantation, management and surgery of the soft tissues around implants and teeth – theory and live surgery

Topics may be subject to minor revision.

4. Certificates.

The stomatologist, after completing the training and passing the exam successfully, receives a certificate of the Duda Clinic of Dental Medicine and a certificate of the training sponsors.

This course meets the continuing education requirements for the International Congress of Implantologists ICOI's Fellowship Credential and contributes to the maintenance requirements for ICOI Fellowship, IPS Mastership and ICOI Diplomate Credentials.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

1. Application form

Application for participation in a training cycle is made electronically and is binding on both parties.

The number of participants is limited, so applications will be accepted in the order of receipt and after payment the minimum reservation fee, until the maximum number of participants is reached. Each edition cannot exceed 15 participants. The minimum group of participants is 10 people, in case of not gathering the group the training will not take place.

Up to 14 days from application receipt by the CDM, participants receive a written confirmation of enrolment and a training schedule.

5. Resignation and change

In the case of resignation less than 30 days before the start of the training, a fee of **5000 EUR + 23% VAT gross** will not be refunded, in the case of resignation more than 30 days before the start of the training a handling fee of 500 EUR gross will be charged. The organizer is not liable for any loss resulting from transportation problems.

6. Inability to participate in the training module

In exceptional cases, if a participant is unable to participate in a training module based on justified and documented reasons, it is possible to participate in another seminar session or to receive material in the next edition. If this is the case, you must contact the CDM immediately.

7. Changes in schedule and program

The CDM, in exceptional circumstances, reserves the right to change the program (which would be slightly different from the planned program) and the dates of the training modules. In this case, the participants will be notified to the correspondence address, e-mail or telephone number. Any claims against the CDM, and in particular claims for compensation or reimbursement of costs incurred due to a change of training date, are excluded.

8. Cancellation / postponing session to another date

In the event of an insufficient number of participants, the CDM reserves the right to cancel a series of courses or postpone them to a later date. If the entire seminar series is canceled, your fees will be refunded immediately, but further claims are excluded.

9. Responsibility

Regarding course dates, schedules, program content and course performance, no claims or demands can be made against the CDM.

10. CURRICULUM STRUCTURE AND REQUIREMENTS

Curriculum is theoretical, observational and practical. The training is based on theoretical lectures, presentations, hands-on workshops, observations and active assistances for patients receiving implantoprosthesis therapy.

The training is intended for general dentists and specialists who are starting to implant or have already introduced basic implantology at their practice. It is also aimed at doctors who work with implantologists and deal only with implantoprosthesis.
